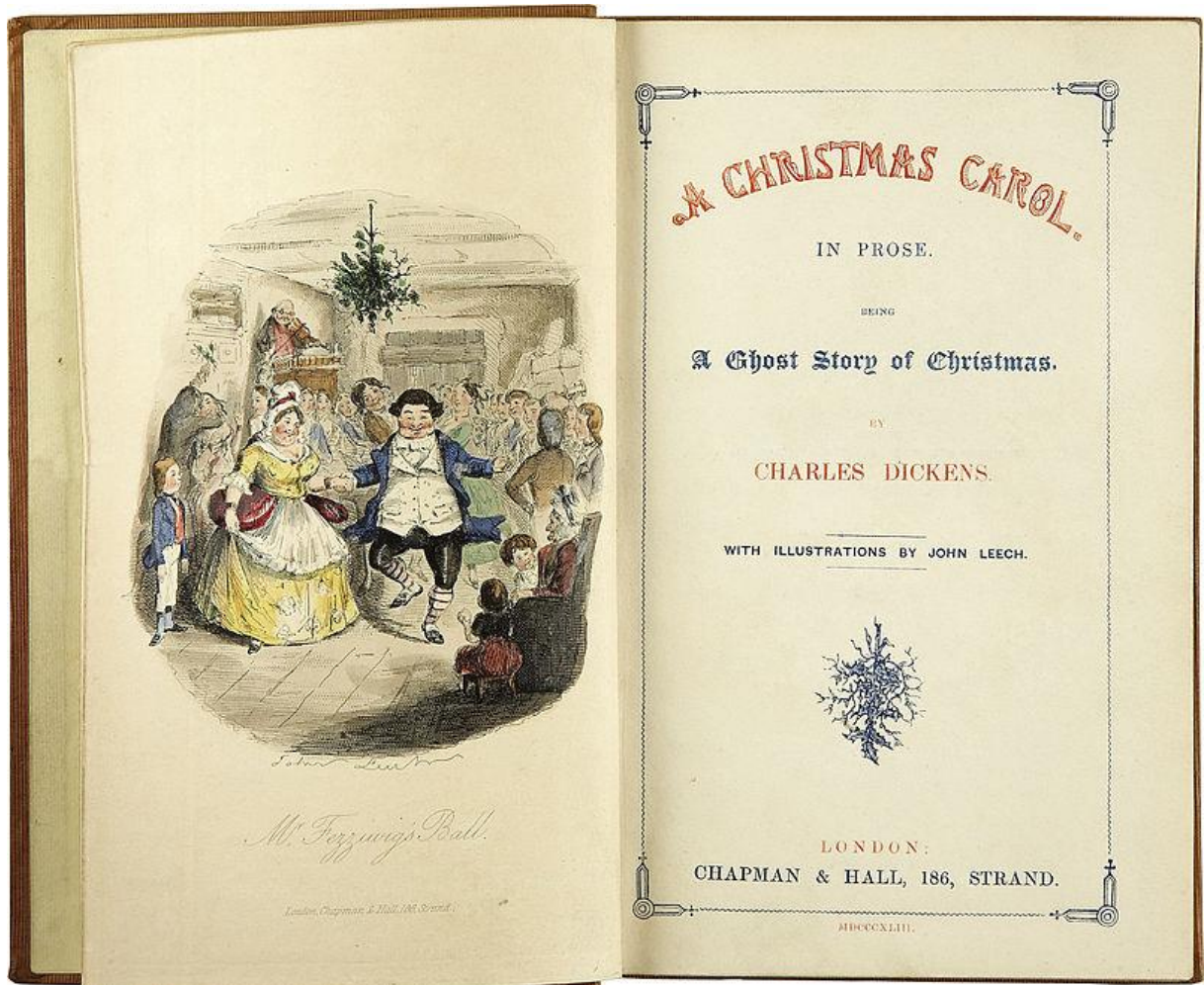


LESSON PLAN



SCHOOL: Gheraseni

CLASS: 7th-8th Form

TITLE OF THE LESSON: "A Christmas Carol" by Charles Dickens

TYPE OF THE LESSON: Reading

SKILLS INVOLVED: Reading /speaking/audiences

TECHNIQUES: role-play

AIMS: -to develop students' speaking skills

- to develop students' reading skills

OBJECTIVES:

-to develop language fluency;

-to improve pronunciation;

-to understand e text (reading comprehension)

ASSUMPTIONS: students have information about Charles Dickens and the Victorian Age

MATERIALS: -Appropriate number of copies of *A Christmas Carol*

-Dictionaries

ACTIVITY 1: Pre-reading (speaking)

- Aims:** -to greet students;
-to create a warm atmosphere;
-to encourage students .

Procedure:

My students' homework was to bring information about Charles Dickens and the Victorian Age. They read their information.

Time: 10 minutes

Teacher's role: organizer

ACTIVITY 2: While-reading (reading/role-play)

- Aims:** - to read with expression his/her part with 80% accuracy;
- to be a respectful listener while participating as an audience member;
- to use the dictionary efficiently and quickly ;
-to develop language fluency.

Procedure:

I ask students to scan the part from **A Christmas Carol** for a few minutes and to underline the unknown words. Then they have to read the whole sentence, trying to guess the meaning of the word. They check up themselves using English-English dictionaries.

After that I ask students to perform the Reader's Theater.

Interaction: Ss-Ss

Time:30 minutes

Teacher's role: provider, organizer

ACTIVITY 3: After-reading (speaking)

Aims:

-to develop language fluency.

Procedure:

❖ I ask students to answer questions about what they have read:

- 1.What is Scrooge's first name? (Ebenezer)
- 2.Who was Scrooge's business partner? (Jacob Marley)
- 3.Who is Bob Cratchit? (Scrooge's secretary)
- 4.Who is Fred? (Scrooge's nephew)
- 5.When did Marley's Ghost visit Scrooge? (On Christmas Eve)
- 6.Why is Marley's Ghost unhappy? (Because he has been traveling since he had died.)
- 7.Why can't Marley's Ghost rest? (Because he was very bad to people when he was alive.)
- 8.What did Marley's Ghost want? (To help Scrooge not to be unhappy when he dies.)

Interaction: T-Ss, Ss-Ss

Time: 7minutes

Teacher's role: feed-back provider

- 1.learn the new words
2. describe Scrooge (one page)
